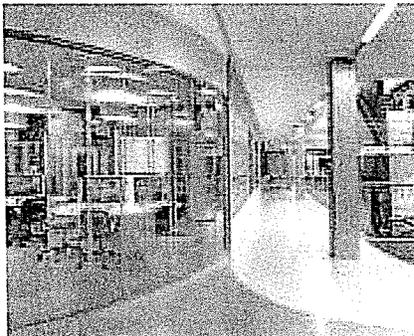
New England Institute of Technology is a private, non-profit technical college that currently offers over 30 Associate's and Bachelor's degree programs.

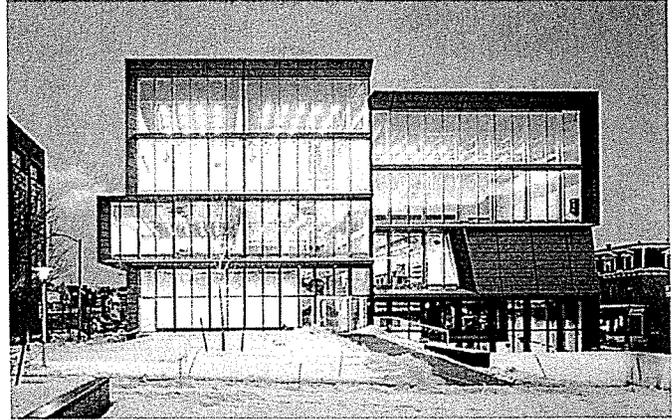

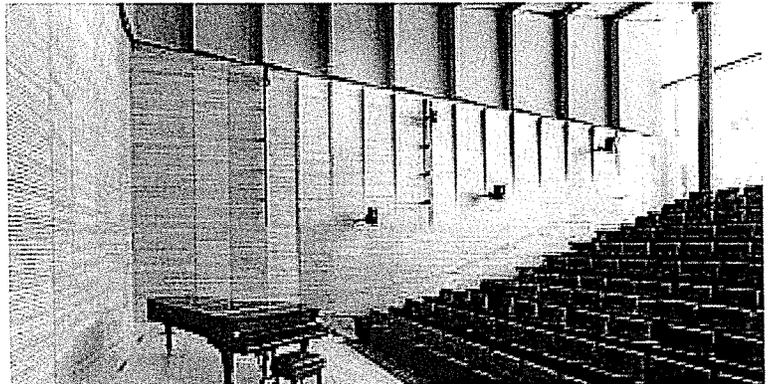
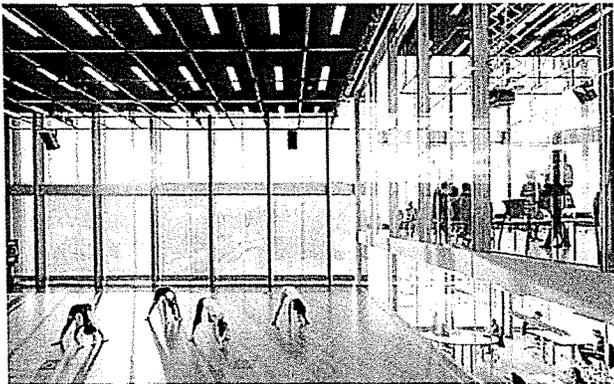


Scope of Work

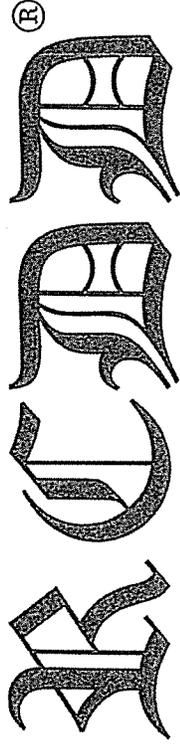

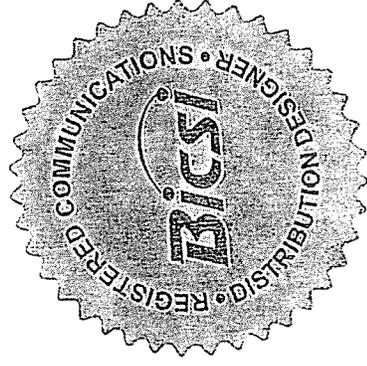

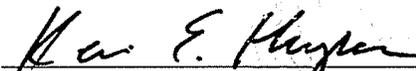
