Addendum #1

Delete Specification Section 06010 2.2- A- 3 and replace with the following language:

3. The pipe handrail/guardrail shall be constructed with mechanically fastened, smooth and continuous A.D.A. Railing System of aluminum fittings as regularly manufactured by The Hollaender Manufacturing Company, 10285 Wayne Avenue, Box 156399, Cincinnati, Ohio 45215-6399, or approved equal. The design of the handrail bracket shall provide a 1 ½" clearance between the post and the rail, and allow for adjustment of the rail to match the angle of the ramp or stairs. Handrail brackets and pipe fittings shall provide a continuous, uninterrupted gripping surface with no sharp edges or projections. The bracket shall be externally connected to the post by means of an anodized aluminum, tubular rivet nut, and an austenitic 302 alloy stainless steel hexagon socket, button head, cap screw. The bracket shall be connected to the underside of the rail by means of two stainless steel, flat countersunk head, Type F self-tapping screws that conform to ANSI/ASME- B18.6.4 Pipe fittings shall be internally connected to the pipe by means of an internal double tang, expanded by an austenitic 302 alloy stainless steel, internal/external, reverse knurl, cup point, hexagon socket set screw. Pop rivets, sheet metal screws, and adhesives shall not be an acceptable fastening method. The brackets and fittings shall be of high tensile aluminum magnesium alloy 535 manufactured in compliance with ASTM B26, cast from high-purity ingot 535.2 conforming to ASTM B179.


